# Standard business rates and charges

These standing offer prices have been approved by the Tasmanian Economic Regulator and apply from 1 July 2026 to 30 June 2027.

Irrigation Time of use periods apply from 1 April to 30 September and peak rates apply from 7am to 10pm Monday to Friday, shoulder rates apply from 7am to 10pm Saturday and Sunday, and Off-Peak rates apply to all other times. From 1 October to 31 March shoulder rates apply from 7am to 10pm Monday to Friday and Off-Peak rates apply at all other times.

General Business (Tariff 22) Obsolete	
From 1 July 2024 new connections for Tariff 22 are no longer possible.	
Daily supply charge	141.9585 ¢/day
First 500 kWh per quarter	32.7539 ¢/kWh
Remainder	27.0439 ¢/kWh

Business hot water supply (Tariff 43) Obsolete	
From 1 July 2024 new connections for Tariff 43 are no longer possible.	
Daily supply charge	19.0175 ¢/day
Energy (all kWh)	20.2734 ¢/kWh

Off-Peak with afternoon boost (Tariff 61) Obsolete	
From 1 July 2019 new connections for Tariff 61 are no longer possible.	
Daily supply charge	24.4450 ¢/day
Energy (all kWh)	14.7348 ¢/kWh

## Additional charges

A late payment fee of \$9.00 applies to accounts not paid in full by the fifth day past the due date (Pensioner, Health Care Card and other exemptions apply).
