Standard residential rates and charges

These standing offer prices have been approved by the Tasmanian Economic Regulator and apply from 1 July 2026 to 30 June 2027.

The following electricity rates and charges are available for private residential dwellings. They do not apply to tourist or hostel accommodation or commercial premises.

Solar Feed-in Tariff (FiT) (Tariff X41) - 140	
Standard Feed in Rate	9.276 cents/kWh
Eligibility: All regulated small customers that have a solar system with a single-phase connection up to 10kW or a solar system with a 3 phase connection up to 30kW.	

Light and power (Tariff 31) Obsolete	
From 1 July 2024 new connections for Tariff 31 are no longer possible.

Heating and Hot water (Tariff 41) Obsolete	
From 1 July 2024 new connections for Tariff 41 are no longer possible.	
Daily supply charge	18.3156 ¢/day
Energy (all kWh)	21.1193 ¢/kWh

Off-Peak with afternoon boost (Tariff 61) Obsolete	
From 1 July 2019 new connections for Tariff 61 are no longer possible.	
Daily supply charge	24.4450 ¢/day
Energy (all kWh)	14.7348 ¢/kWh

Additional charges

A late payment fee of \$9.00 applies to accounts not paid in full by the fifth day past the due date (Pensioner, Health Care Card and other exemptions apply).

Overdue accounts for Standard Retail Contract customers may be charged interest that reflects the 90-day Bank Accepted Bill rate (plus 6%), as set by the Reserve Bank of Australia for the relevant quarter.
